Pursuant to Government Code section 25259.7 and with the approval of the Court's Executive Officer, the Fiscal Manager of the Enhanced Collections Program has applied for a discharge from accountability for the court-ordered debts that it would otherwise be responsible for collecting. The debts/accounts are set forth on the Discharge Report dated June 12, 2024, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference, as though set forth fully and at length.

The Court finds that each of the debts/accounts listed in Exhibit A are too small to justify the continued cost of collection, and/or the likelihood of collection does not warrant the expense involved.

1           Good cause appearing therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that  
2 pursuant to Government Code section 25259.9, this Court's Enhanced  
3 Collections Program is discharged from further accountability as  
4 to every debt/account set forth in Exhibit A, and is relieved from  
5 any further responsibility for collecting these debts/accounts.  
6 This Order shall have the same effect as a discharge from  
7 accountability under Government Code section 25259.

8           As further provided in Government Code section 25259.9,  
9 nothing in this Order shall be construed as releasing or relieving  
10 any person from liability for payment of any amount for said  
11 debts/accounts.


12           Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code section  
13 25259.9, subdivision (a), this Court's Executive Officer, as Clerk  
14 of the Court, is directed to forthwith enter record of this  
15 discharge in the Court case file for each debt/account, and to  
16 post a copy of this Order of Discharge on the Court's Internet Web  
17 site for a period of not less than three weeks. The Court  
18 Executive Officer, or his/her designee, shall maintain a written  
19 record verifying posting of this Order to the court's Internet Web  
20 site as set forth above.

21           Pursuant to Government Code section 25259.9, subdivision (b),  
22 within 45 days after the end of the month in which this Order is  
23 executed, the Court's Executive Officer shall report to the County  
24 of Fresno this discharge from accountability for the court-ordered  
25 debts set forth in Exhibit A, that the Court would otherwise have  
26 been responsible for collecting. The report shall, at a include

1. The case number;
  2. Whether the case is an infraction, misdemeanor, or felony;
  3. The amount of the debt discharged; and
  4. The number of years since the debt became delinquent.
- The Court Executive Officer, or his/her designee, shall maintain a written record of providing the report to the County of Fresno.
