This proposal is published for public comment from October 1, 2024, with a deadline of December 2, 2024. After that date, the comments will be reviewed and modifications will be made to the proposal, if necessary. These changes are a result of the Court's strategic planning for operational efficiency. The temporary relocation of departments from the "M" Street and B.F. Sisk Courthouses to the Main Courthouse and the Juvenile Justice Courthouse on these dates will provide the Court with the opportunity to better utilize staff resources.
